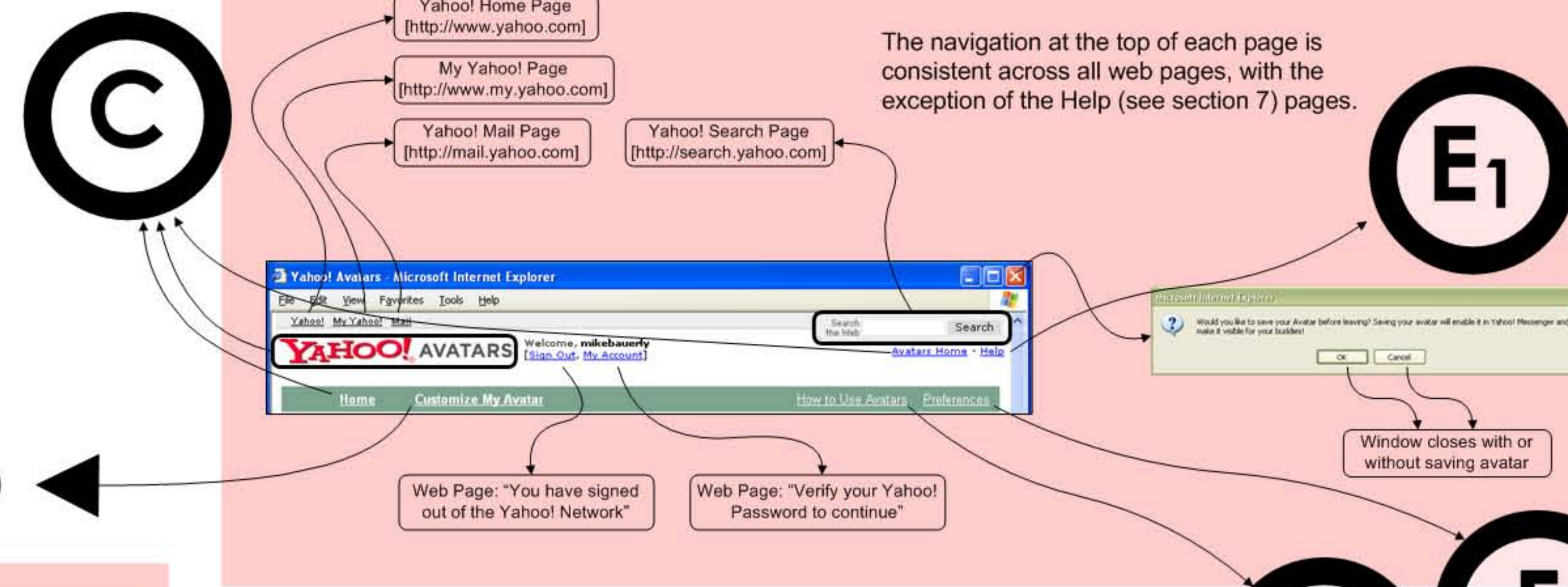

2. Customize My Avatar

There are two types of Customization pages that are found under the five tabs. The basic page style is the template for the Apparel, Extras, Backgrounds, and Branded tabs while the appearance tab has a custom template. Example screenshots of each template style are shown along with a full outline of all the possible customization pages.

Customize My Avatar

Clicking on any outfit places that outfit on the avatar and puts it in the "What I'm trying on" list.

Clicking on a skin color square changes the avatar's skin color.

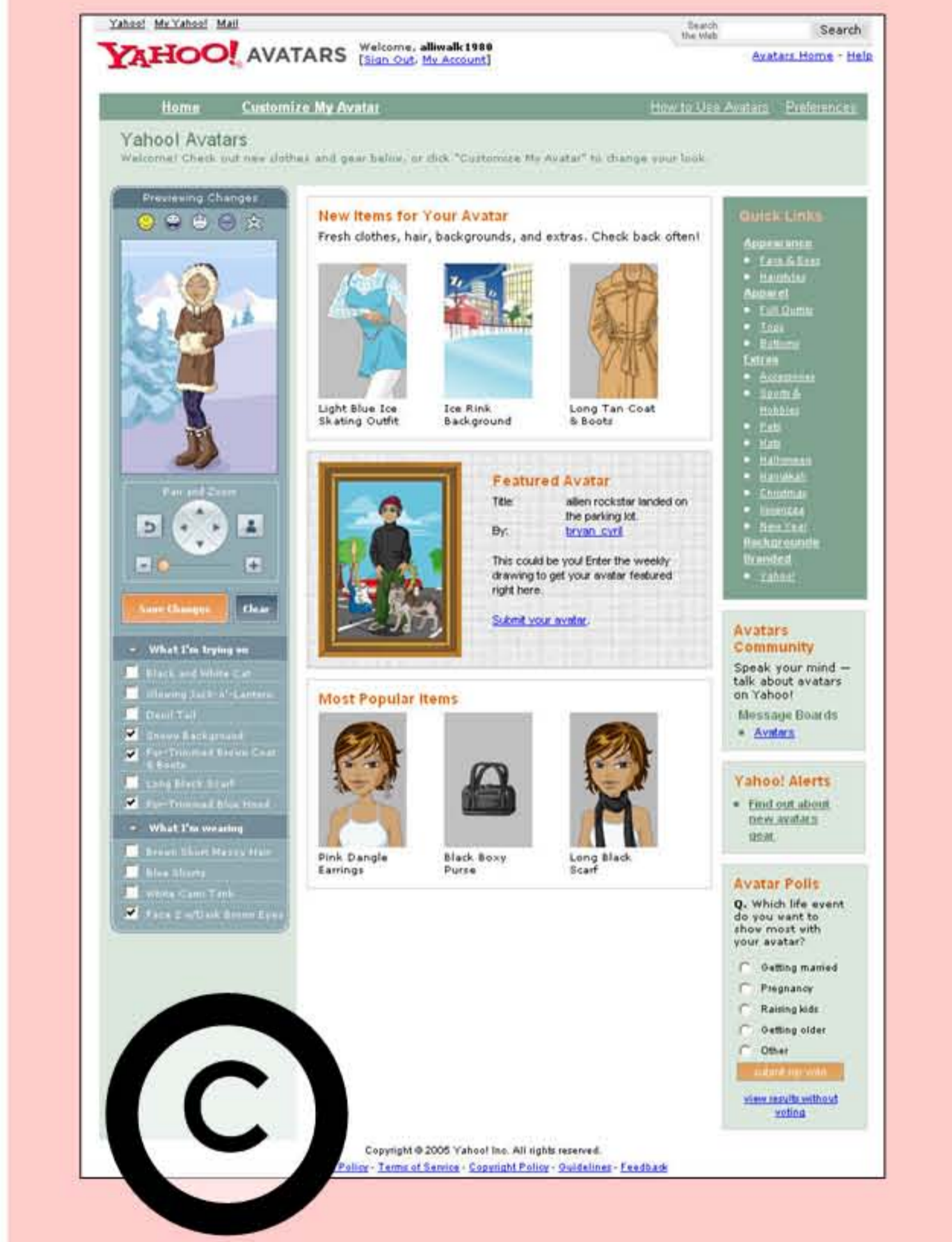
Clicking on a face changes the avatar's face structure and eye color to the last listed below that face. It also places the changes in the "What I'm trying on" list.

Clicking on an eye color changes the avatar's eyes that color and changes the face structure to whichever one is to the left of the clicked color. It also places the changes in the "What I'm trying on" list.

Clicking on a hairstyle changes the avatar's hair that color and changes the hairstyle to whichever one is to the left of the clicked color. It also places the changes in the "What I'm trying on" list.

Clicking on a hair color changes the avatar's hair that color and changes the hairstyle to whichever one is to the left of the clicked color. It also places the changes in the "What I'm trying on" list.

5. Avatar Control Panel

The Avatar Control Panel is available on every page except for the Help pages. It displays each Customization element as it is selected (see section 4). The control panel allows each element to be removed from the Avatar easily. When a check mark is placed next to the elements in the lists, they are shown on the avatar, and they are hidden when the check mark is removed.

Save Changes: Click here to save the elements you have selected.

What I'm Trying On: Shows the elements that have been selected and are on display. These elements have not yet been saved. An element may be removed by clicking on the check to uncheck the box.

What I'm Wearing: Shows the elements that have been saved. The elements that are being displayed each have a check in front of them. The elements that are now default, are blank.
